Robyn Luhning is a sustainability expert with over two decades of corporate experience leading, developing, and implementing sustainable solutions to support the environment, communities and the economy.

As Wells Fargo & Company's first Chief Sustainability Officer, she was responsible for driving enterprise Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) programs, and leading progress against the

company's climate and other sustainability initiatives. She also led the development of the Wells Fargo Institute for Sustainable Finance, which served as a hub for the bank's climate-related programming and stakeholder engagement. Robyn joined Wells Fargo in 2011 in the company's first full-time role focused on Environmental and Social Risk Management.

Earlier in her career, Luhning advised Fortune 500 companies on sustainability and corporate responsibility strategy. She also held a variety of corporate responsibility roles for large companies and served as a Peace Corps Volunteer in Madagascar.
