## Philippe Le Corre Senior Fellow on Foreign Policy Center for China Analysis

Philippe Le Corre is a senior fellow with the Asia Society Policy Institute's Center for China Analysis specializing in China's interactions with the world (especially Europe, Eurasia and the US), EU-China relations, competition in the Asia-Pacific region, and Chinese overseas investments. Le Corre is also a senior adviser to Asia Society France, an Associate in Research with Harvard's Fairbank Center for Chinese Studies; and a Visiting Professor with ESSEC Business School in Paris.

Philippe Le Corre previously worked for Brookings and The Carnegie Endowment for International Peace. He previously served as a Special Assistant for international affairs and counsellor to the French defense minister, and as a senior policy adviser on Asia. He has testified multiple times before the U.S. House of Representatives' Committee on Foreign Affairs, the French Senate and the French National Assembly on the topic of Chinese investment and influence in Europe and is the author or co-author of seven books on Chinese affairs and many other publications including Does the rise of China threaten the transatlantic relationship? In China Questions 2 (Harvard University Press, 2022) and China's influence in Southeastern, Eastern and Central European countries: Vulnerabilities and Resilience, (Carnegie, 2021).
