Martha Delgado is a former Mexican government minister and renowned environmentalist with over 30 years of experience in public service. From 2018 to 2023, she served as Undersecretary for Multilateral Affairs and Human Rights at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, where she led Mexico's feminist foreign policy and spearheaded the country's global economic strategy. Under her

leadership, Mexico attracted nearly \$9 billion in foreign investment, including expansions from BMW and Tesla, and launched innovative initiatives like the Transport Electrification Working Group to drive electromobility. Martha was elected the first president of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) Assembly from 2019-2023. During the COVID-19 pandemic, she managed critical efforts to procure medical supplies and secure vaccines for Mexico. Previously, she served as Mexico City's Secretary of Environment, where she implemented pioneering sustainability projects, including the ECOBICI bike-sharing system. Martha is the Chair of Mexico and Latin America for APCO, where she also serves as a member of the International Advisory Board.
