Tony is global head of Corporate Communications at Goldman Sachs, a role he has held since joining the firm as a partner in 2022. Previously, he founded Hamilton Place Strategies (now Penta Group), and prior to that, he served in the White House as deputy assistant to President George W. Bush and principal deputy press secretary, and in senior roles with three US Treasury

secretaries; including as Assistant Secretary of the Treasury for Public Affairs. Outside of Goldman Sachs, he serves as chair of the board of World Food Program USA, serves on the boards of directors of the Center for Global Development, and the Urban Institute. Tony also serves as a trustee of the U.S. Olympics and Paralympics Foundation, and the School of Public Affairs at the University of Pittsburgh – his alma mater.
